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## GENERAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. The application for admission should be filed with the Graduate Psychology Program.
2. All applicants must have completed an undergraduate degree from a regionally accredited institution. An official transcript from that institution must be submitted. Official transcripts from all institutions attended must be submitted. Transcripts marked "Issued to Student" are not acceptable. Official transcripts must be sent from all colleges/universities attended directly to the Graduate Psychology Program.
3. Graduate applicants must arrange to take either the Miller Analogies Test (MAT) or the Graduate Record Exam (GRE). The MAT is administered on campus through the Center for Leadership, Calling, and Service. The fee is \$65.00 with checks made payable to Trevecca. Test registration information may be obtained by calling 248-1346.
4. Applicants who wish to take a limited number of courses for personal or professional development or for transferring to another institution may enroll under the designation NON-DEGREE STUDENT. Please note that NON-DEGREE STUDENTS are not eligible for student loans. A limit of nine hours earned as a non-degree student may be applied toward a master's degree program. Students who have already earned a graduate degree and are taking classes for licensure purposes should apply as DEGREED; LICENSURE SEEKING. DEGREED; LICENSURE SEEKING students are eligible for student loans.
5. A *non-refundable application* fee of \$25.00 is required with all applications.

## ADMISSION CRITERIA

### Academic Credentials:

The applicant must have completed an undergraduate degree with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.7 (on a 4.0 scale) to be admitted as a degree seeking student. If this requirement is not met, admission dependent on academic progress may be permitted provided the test score meets minimum standards.

### Nationally Recognized Aptitude Measures:

Degree seeking applicants are required to submit an acceptable score from either the MAT (minimum 380) or GRE (minimum 800 combined Verbal and Quantitative). If this requirement is not met, admission dependent on academic progress may be permitted provided the cumulative grade point average meets minimum standards.

### Reference Assessment:

Two reference assessment forms must be completed by employers, supervisors or other qualified individuals.
