Jyngle

With snow storms and spring tornadoes possible, the following information could save you some trouble. JYNGLE is a free emergency alert system that will call or text message subscribers when an emergency occurs at Trevecca. Subscribing takes only a few seconds and can be done online at <http://jyngle.trevecca.edu>. The automatic system will confirm the subscription by calling the phone listed on the online form, so a subscriber must be near the listed phone to take the confirmation call. Persons must subscribe to JYNGLE annually. (If you subscribed last year, you need to re-subscribe.) Your phone number is confidential with JYNGLE; no other organization can gain access to your number.

JYNGLE will warn you when Trevecca experiences an emergency. Be one of the first to know.
